ETL Meeting Update – Corinne Crowley

- The Board reviewed the agenda and notes from the September 29, 2021 ETL Boys Directors' Meeting.
- 18 programs intend to field ETL teams this season.
- Games will be starting in December, with playoffs/state tournament in March; no Feeder Bowl.
- Many programs have already held tryouts or will do so shortly.
- ETL needs to know ASAP if and how many teams NSBBC will be fielding.
- October 25: Deadline to submit ETL fees (\$1,100) and dates for use of gyms for home games.
- November 1: Deadline to send ETL our list of COVID protocols/requirements for home games.

2021/2022 Season update - Cory Sparling

- Teams for 6th, 7th, and 8th grade, with 10-player roster maximums.
- No 4th or 5th grade team, but 5th graders can tryout to play up with 6th grade team.
- Coaches committed: Kendrick, Chevy, Caleb, Terrence, and Julian.
- Kendrick and Chevy will coach 7th and 8th grade teams and Caleb will shadow; Julian will coach 6th grade team.
- Terrance will run training program for players who don't make a team (5th 8th grade); players can be called up to play for an ETL team.
- Practices two nights per week at Tillicum; 6th 8th grade teams + training program will be divided by time and into upper vs. lower gym.
- EBC and Local Hoops are interested in scheduling scrimmage games.
- Cost: The Board approved a fee of \$625 with no tournaments for now; tournament opportunities will be analyzed separately, and additional amounts may be charged upon deciding to participate.
- Uniforms: The Board will approve either (1) purchasing new uniforms to be checked out and returned at the end of the reason, or (2) partially subsidizing the cost for players to purchase their own uniforms. Cory will obtain quotes.

Tryouts – Cory Sparling

- Occurring over two days, with no parents allowed in the gym. Options:
 - October 18 and 20; invitations sent by October 22, with 24-hour deadline to accept; rosters sent to ETL by the October 25 deadline.
 - Weekend tryout (Saturday and Sunday) if gym space is available.
- Cory will secure gym space, create flyer/advertisement, and complete ETL paperwork.
- The Board approved a tryout fee of \$15 for new players; free for players currently enrolled in training.
- Photos will be taken at check-in; Cory will order numbers for players to wear.
- Cory will work on a flyer/advertisement.
- Garrett will coordinate with Tillicum PTA to distribute flyers (newsletter, Facebook page, etc.); Corrine will coordinate with Tyee PTA.
