Summary:

- 1. The Newport select program had a great year with 4 teams went to State tournament.
- 2. 115 kids signed up at 2025 fall tryout.
- 3. Program budget: beginning balance at \$13,000, collected season fee from player registration around \$70,000, there are expenses during last season included coaches stipend, total 9 teams: 4 teams' ETL registration fees and 5 other teams' Peak league registration fees, every team has 2 outside tournament and each tournament has around registration fees \$250 \$350 per team, every player receives one hoody, remaining balance is around \$6,000.
- 4. Bellevue school district typically does its best to help facilitate and secure gym space when there are events preventing our program to use the gym.
- 5. Huge thank you to Cory (former president) and Janice K as they roll off the Newport board.
- 6. New board members: Christina Chen and Zhi Zhou, no objection and voted in, welcome!
- 7. By Law Amendment: regarding ETL rules regarding player eligibility to play in the Newport program. Either players parent with home address in the school zone feed into the Newport program or the players parent works in the Bellevue school district. The amendment is adopted with no objection.
- 8. The Newport Select program participates in 2 leagues: in general, the Gold teams play in the ETL league and the Red teams play in the Peak league. ETL league's game either travel to different school's home court or Newport home game play in Newport high school. League games typically start early Nov and end mid-March then between the league play the program will put in additional outside tournament games according to team availability.
- 9. For State tournament: to qualify for State tournament, each team either win or come in 2nd in outside State qualifying tournaments or the team comes in 1st or 2nd in the ETL league.

- 10. Playing time philosophy: the program's general goal is to help player improve on their skill level and play time is based on skill level, earned through practice participation and willingness to focus on improvement.
- 11. Coach overview: most of the coaches in the program have been with the program for several years. Only one of coaches this year is new to the program, and he played in Newport select and Newport high school varsity team as well.
- 12. Code of conduct: encourage all players and parents to review the code of conduct to familiarize yourself with the expectation.
- 13. Student verification: if you are on the Gold team every player needs to provide screen shot of Bellevue School district home screen to verify the address fall under Newport program. ETL team parent is responsible for collecting the screen shots and coordinating team bonding activities, and State tournament arrangement.
